

report by said commissioners, or a majority of them, in the office of the clerk of the counties of Marathon and Taylor, said road shall be a public highway, and be deemed to be opened and established for highway purposes.

SECTION 3. The board of supervisors of each of the counties of Marathon and Taylor may appropriate such sums of money as they may deem proper, not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500) in any one year, for the purpose of opening and approving [improving] said road. Supervisors may appropriate money.

SECTION 4. Such commissioners shall be entitled to such compensation as the board of supervisors of each county, through which said road shall pass, shall deem proper, and the same shall be paid by said counties respectively, in proportion to the distance of said road in each county; *provided*, that no compensation shall ever be allowed from the state treasury for such service. Compensation of commissioners.

SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 24.

[Published February 17, 1876.]

AN ACT to provide for the laying out and establishing of a state road from Shioc-ton, in Outagamie county, to Clintonville, in Waupaca county.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. S. B. Bedding, W. D. Jordan and Seely Budd, are hereby appointed to lay out and establish a state road, commencing at some point to be designated by said commissioners, in the village of Shioc-ton, in the county of Outagamie, and running thence, as near as may be, upon the most feasible route, in the judgment of said commissioners, to Clintonville, in the county of Waupaca. Commissioners. Course of road.

SECTION 2. Any two of said commissioners may proceed to lay out and establish said road, and upon the performance of said service shall be entitled to receive a reasonable compensation therefor, from the Compensation of commissioners.

counties through which said road shall pass; *provided*, that no part of said expense shall be paid out of the state treasury.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 25.

[Published February 23, 1876.]

AN ACT to create a municipal court for the county of Chippewa.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Municipal
court created.

SECTION 1. There is hereby created and established in and for the county of Chippewa, a municipal court with the powers and jurisdiction hereinafter specified and provided.

Municipal
judge—when

SECTION 2. On the first Tuesday of April, A. D. 1877, and every four years thereafter, there shall be elected in the county of Chippewa, in the same manner county judges are elected, one municipal judge, who shall hold his office for the term of four years and until his successor is elected and qualified.

Powers and
duties of muni-

SECTION 3. The municipal judge of the county of Chippewa, shall have jurisdiction to try and determine all actions at law wherein the amount claimed shall not exceed the sum of five hundred dollars, and to try and determine all criminal actions where the crime was committed in said county and that are not punishable by commitment to the state prison, and to arrest and examine and hold to bail all parties charged with other offenses against the laws of this state, as provided by law, and of all penalties and offenses against the charter, ordinances, and regulations lawfully imposed by the city of Chippewa Falls, and shall have all the jurisdiction given by law to each and every justice of the peace and police justice of said county, and the proceedings and practice of said court shall in all respects, as far as practical, comply with the laws of justices' courts of this state, and transcripts of the judgments of the municipal court, shall be with like effect filed and entered with the clerk of the circuit court of said county, and all appeals, civil
