## CHAPTER 339.

[Published April 1, 1876.]

AN ACT to repeal chapter three hundred and forty-eight (348), of the laws of Wisconsin of 1874. entitled, "An act to amend chapter forty-six (46), of the general laws of 1869, entitled, an act to protect the lands and timber granted to the St. Croix and Lake Superior Railroad Company."

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senute and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter three hundred and forty-eight Repealed. (348), of the laws of Wisconsin of 1874, entitled, "An act to amend chapter forty-six (46), of the general laws of 1869, entitled, 'an act to protect the lands and timber granted to the St. Croix and Lake Superior Railroad Company," is hereby repealed. And section three (3), of chapter forty-six (46), of the general laws of 1869, entitled, "An act to protect the Re-enacted lands and timber thereon, granted to the St. Croix and Lake Superior Railroad Company," is hereby revived, re-enacted and declared to be in full force, virtue and effect as it was before the passage of said chapter three hundred and forty-eight (348), of the laws of Wisconsin, of 1874.

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force

from and after its passage and publication.
