

CHAPTER 398.

[Published April 7, 1876.]

AN ACT to change the time for holding the circuit court in Grant county, in the Fifth circuit, and to fix the days of commencement of the terms of the circuit court of the Fifth judicial circuit.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

When terms in various counties shall be held.

SECTION 1. The general term of the circuit court of the Fifth judicial circuit shall be held in the county of Grant on the first Tuesday in February and the second Tuesday in September in each year; in the county of Iowa on the fourth Tuesday in March and the first Tuesday in October in each year; in the county of La Fayette on the fourth Tuesday in June and the first Tuesday in December in each year; in the county of Richland on the second Tuesday in April and the fourth Tuesday in October in each year; in the county of Crawford on the fourth Tuesday in May and second Tuesday in November in each year; and all writs, notices, motions, orders, services, processes, proceedings and recognizances, commenced, made or entered into, in or from said court or for said counties, and all proceedings pending therein, or returnable thereto, whether by recognizance or otherwise, shall be held and taken as returnable on the days above mentioned.

SECTION 2. All acts or parts of acts in conflict with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed, and this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
