## CHAPTER 289.

AN ACT to prohibit the employment of children under twelve years of age in factories or other workshops in this state.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. It shall hereafter be unlawful to employ Unlawful to any child or children under twelve years of age at any dren in places manual labor in any factory or other workshop where health. more than three persons are employed in this state, which shall be deemed injurious to the health of such/975/95 children, as tobacco and cigar factories, cotton and woolen mills, and iron foundries, and during the time that the public schools are not closed.

Any person or persons, company or cor- Penalty for vioporation violating the provisions of this act, shall, upon conviction thereof, be adjudged guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall pay a fine of not more than fity dollars or less than ten dollars, with the costs of prosecution, and shall be imprisoned in the county fail of the proper county, until such fine and costs are paid, or until discharged from such imprisonment by due course of
