## CHAPTER 63.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money therein named for the payment of pensions of soldiers' orphans, as provided in chapter 72 of the laws of 1874.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

**Appropriation.** SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the general fund not otherwise appropriated, the sum of one thousand dollars in full for the payment of pensions of soldiers' orphans, as provided in chapter 72 of the laws of 1874, for the year 1877.

**How money to be drawn.** SECTION 2. All sums of money appropriated by this act shall be drawn from the treasury not oftener than quarterly.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 64.

AN ACT to amend sections five and nine of chapter 193, of the laws of 1873, entitled "An act to change the management of the state prison, and to amend and consolidate all laws concerning the same,"

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

**Amended.** SECTION 1. Section five of chapter 193, of the laws of Wisconsin of 1873 is hereby amended by striking out all after the word "turnkey," in the third line of said section, and inserting the following: "One matron for the female prison department and such guards, overseers and laborers as may be necessary," so that said section shall read, when amended, as follows: "Section 5. The officers of the prison shall consist of three directors, one warden, one deputy warden, one clerk, one chaplain, one gate-keeper, one turnkey, one matron for the female prison department, and such guards, overseers and laborers as may be necessary."

**Amended.** SECTION 2. Section nine of said chapter 193, is here-
