Repairs.

SECTION 6. Such road shall be worked and kept in repair by the towns in which it may be located as on other highways.

SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 165.

AN ACT to legalize the acts of the common council of the city of Chippewa Falls, relating to street work, and to authorize the assessment and collection of the amount thereof as a special tax.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Legalized.

Special tax.

SECTION 1. The proceedings of the common council of the city of Chippewa Falls, Wisconsin, in the grading of Spring street in the city of Chippewa Falls, Wisconsin graded by Hall & Brandett, under order of the common council of said city and under their contract therefor of August 5, 1875, is hereby legalized and made of as full force and effect as if the same had corresponded fully with all of the requirements and provisions of sub-chapter eleven, chapter one hundred and sixtynine, laws of Wisconsin of 1873, and the amendment thereto.

SECTION 2. The proper authorities of said city are hereby authorized to order that the amount of the unpaid certificates for the grading of said street be assessed to and upon the lots of land respectively upon which the same is chargeable, and to enter the same upon the next annual tax roll as a special tax, to be collected therefrom for the benefit of the holders of said certificates and to proceed to collect the same according to law as other taxes on real estate are collected by virtue

of the laws of this state, except that personal property shall not be seized or sold for the payment thereof.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
