CHAPTER 33.

AN ACT authorizing and requiring the Wisconsin Farm Mortgage Land Commissioners appointed under chapter 446 of the private and local laws of 1868, to extend the benefits of said act to certain other parties equitably entitled thereto.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Authority of commissioners

SECTION 1. The Wisconsin Farm Mortgage Land Commissioners, appointed under chapter 446 of the private and local laws of 1868, are hereby authorized and required to extend the benefits of such act until the 1st day of May, 1878, for the purpose of allowing said commissioners to consider any other claims justly coming within the provisions of said act.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in

force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 84.

AN ACT to provide for the collection of special taxes in certain cases.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Authority of town supervisors; duty of clerk, etc.

Section 1. Whenever the qualified electors of any town, at any legal meeting, shall have voted to raise money for the purpose of building or repairing any bridge or town-house or other special purpose, to the amount of one thousand dollars or more, more than six months previous to the time for the completion and delivery to the town treasurer for collection of the next regular annual tax roll of such town, the supervisors of such town may, in their discretion, require the clerk of such town to make out a tax roll by copying the last regular annual tax-roll of said town, excepting the taxes specified therein, and upon the roll so made out, to apportion and carry out the special tax so voted to be raised. The said clerk shall attach to said roll, when completed, a warrant in the usual form, excepting that such warrant shall require the treasurer to re-
