CHAPTER 62.

AN ACT relating to the reduction of the price of swamp and overflowed lands in Monroe county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows.

SECTION 1. The commissioners of school and university lands are hereby authorized in their discretion to reduce the price of all swamp and overflowed lands now owned by the state in Monroe county, and that have not been once sold, and all such lands that have been once sold and forfeited to the state and are now held by the state, to the uniform price of fifty cents per acre, with the amounts of unpaid taxes added to the price of such lands sold as aforesaid: *provided*, that the above reduction shall not apply to any of said lands now under contract, and which may hereafter become forfeited to the state, until the expiration of two years after such forfeiture.
