## CHAPTER 142.

AN ACT to provide for the laying out of a state road in the counties of Waupaca, Shawano and Oconto.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. That there shall be a state road laid Route. out, four rods in width, as follows: Beginning at the village of Clintonville, in the town of Larabee, Waupaca county, on the most feasible route from said village of Clintonville to Pella, in the town of Pella, thence on the most feasible route to Leopolis, in the town of Herman, Shawano county, thence north on the most feasible route west of the center line of south range fourteen, and east of the range line between south ranges thirteen and fourteen east of the fourth principal meridian, to the town line between townships thirty and thirty-one, thence north on the most feasible route west of the range line of north range fourteen and east of the center line of north range thirteen east of the fourth principal meridian, to the state line between the state of Wisconsin and the state of Michigan.

SECTION 2. That T. M. Dobbs, L. H. Taylor and Commissioners; their duties. L. J. Marsh, of the town of Langlade, Oconto county, and John Goodwin, of the town of Herman, Shawano county, and W. H. Stacy, of Clintonville, town of Larabee, Waupaca county, are hereby made commissioners for the laying out and superintending the building of said road and bridges; and when said road is so laid out and built complete, it shall be a turnpike as near as may be on the center line of said road, of not less than eight feet in width on each side of the center line of said turnpike; said turnpike to be made from the earth taken from the ditches along each side of said road as far as it is practicable to do so, and when necessary the dirt shall be hauled from the most convenient place to build said turnpike; all ditches shall be made in such a manuer that they will make a thorough drainage of all water from the ditches on either side of the turnpike; and all bridges that are necessary to be built on said road shall not be less than twenty feet in width, and shall be built in a good, substantial and workmanlike manner, and in form and style most appropriate to the stream and place where they are to cross said streams.

Officers, treasurer to give bonds.

SECTION 3. The first named commissioner shall be chairman of said board of commissioners; said board of commissioners shall elect a secretary and treasurer out of its number; said treasurer shall give bonds for the faithful discharge of the several duties imposed upon him as treasurer of said board in double the amount of all moneys that would come in his possession from any source for the use of said road, said bond to be approved by the majority of the board; the said treasurer shall pay out all money on the order of said board, signed by the secretary and countersigned by the chairman of said board, and a majority of said board of commissioners shall make a quorum for the transaction of all business pertaining to said road; when said road is laid out and surveyed, the survey and laying out of the road shall be recorded and made record of, in each of the several towns through which it passes, as the survey and the laying out of a state road from the village of Clintonville, in the town of Larabee, Waupaca county, north to the state line between the state of Wisconsin and the state of Michigan.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

### CHAPTER 143.

AN ACT to authorize A. J. Hayward and W. E. McCord to build a dam across, and otherwise improve Little Chief river, in Chippewa county, Wisconsin, for log driving purposes.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

Dam authorized; where located.

SECTION 1. A. J. Hayward and W. E. McCord, their heirs and assigns, are hereby authorized to erect and maintain a dam on the northeast quarter of the north east quarter of section twenty-six (26), town forty (40), range seven (7) west, in Chippewa county, Wisconsin, across Little Chief river, and otherwise improve said river for driving logs, by closing sloughs, building booms, and clearing and straightening the channel of said river, and to keep said dam and other improvements in repair, and operate and use the same for the purpose of facilitating the driving and floating of all
