CHAPTER 156.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled an act to incorporate the city of Watertown, and the several acts amendatory thereof, approved March 28, 1865, relating to the powers and duties of officers.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Whenever the assessors of the city of Watertown have completed their assessment, the same shall be filed by them in the office of the city clerk, to be reviewed and corrected as hereinafter provided. Filing of assessment.

SECTION 2. The board of street commissioners of said city shall constitute a board of review, with the same powers and duties as are now provided by law: *provided, further,* said board may require the assessors to appear before said board, from time to time, to give such information as may be required, but they shall not be deemed members of the board. Board of review.

SECTION 3. The said board of street commissioners, sitting as a board of review, shall review, correct and complete the assessment roll, in the manner provided by law, and shall receive the same compensation per day as assessors for the time actually employed. Duty of board of review.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 157.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the city of Chilton.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section nine of chapter eight, of chapter eighty-nine, of the laws of 1877, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: The treasurer of the fire department shall receive and pay out all moneys belonging to said department, and shall secure the faithful performance of his duties by his bond to said city in such penal sum as shall be required by and with sureties to be approved by the common council.
