CHAPTER 175.

AN ACT to authorize the payment of expenses in securing lands to which the state is or may be entitled.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. All expenses connected with securing and selecting public lands to which this state is or may be entitled, shall be paid from the fund to which the proceeds from the sale thereof will be added; and accounts therefor, when approved by the governor, shall be audited by the secretary of state and paid by the state treasurer from the proper fund, as herein directed; and there is hereby appropriated out of said funds a sum sufficient to pay such expenses. Expenses, how paid.

SECTION 2. This act shall apply to expenses incurred since the first day of November last, as well as subsequent to its passage. This act retro-active.]

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 176.

AN ACT to establish a board of immigration.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There shall be a board of immigration in this state, which shall be composed of five (5) members, who shall receive no compensation for their services rendered under this act, and who shall annually make report of their doings to the legislature. Number and compensation of board.

SECTION 2. The governor and secretary of state shall be *ex-officio* members of this board, and the other Ex-officio member.
