

SECTION 2. All money held by the treasurer of the town of Amberst, in pursuance of the provisions of the act hereby repealed, shall be by said treasurer turned over and credited to the poor fund of said town. Moneys to be credited to poor fund.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 61.

AN ACT relating to the circuit court of Winnebago county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The circuit court of the county of Winnebago shall be deemed to be open for the transaction of business from the commencement of one regular term to the commencement of another, and an adjournment of the term from day to day shall not be necessary to the validity of any proceeding therein. Sessions to be continuous.

SECTION 2. The term of the circuit court in the county of Winnebago, held on Tuesday after the first Monday in September, is hereby abolished. Term abolished

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 62.

AN ACT to authorize the city of Racine to borrow money for the support of paupers.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The common council of the city of Racine is hereby authorized to borrow a sum not exceeding two thousand dollars (\$2,000), from any available funds in the hands of its treasurer, for the support of the poor of said city. Council to borrow \$2,000.

SECTION 2. The sum authorized to be borrowed under this act is to be paid from the receipts of the poor fund for license, on or before July 1st, 1879. Payment of loan.
