## CHAPTER 78.

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter three hundred and twenty-seven of the laws of Wisconsin of 1874, and section one of chapter two hundred and sixty-two of the laws of Wis-consin of 1878, entitled an act relating to swamp and over-flowed lands in the counties of Manitowoc and Calumet.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter three hundred Names of com-and twenty-seven, laws of Wisconsin of 1874, entitled missioners. "an act relating to swamp and overflowed lands in the counties of Manitowoc and Calumet, for draining and other purposes," is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Christian Artischen and Julius Feind, of Calumet county, and Ira Clark, John Hollaran, Frederick Swensen and Thos. Gleason, of Manitowoc county, are hereby appointed commissioners, to be known as the board of Manitowov and Calumet swamp land commissioners, who shall elect one of their number secre- secretary and tary and one of their number treasurer, and as such commissioners they are hereby authorized and empowered to act for and on behalf of said counties in the Duties of comexecution of the trust by this act created; and by this missioners. said name shall be capable in law of taking, holding, leasing and contracting for, selling and conveying the lands or any portion thereof, described in the first section of this act, and appropriating the money arising from the sale thereof, so far as the same may be necessary, for the purposes named in this act, and no further; and in that name may contract and be contracted with, sue and be sued, may have a common seal, and alter and renew the same at pleasure, and may have and exercise all the powers, rights and privileges and immunities which are or may be necessary to carry into effect the purposes and objects of this act as the same are herein set forth.

This act shall take effect and be in SECTION 2. force from and after its passage.
