Section 24. The franchises, privileges and immunities heretofore granted to said railroad company are hereby extended and continued in full force and operation until the first day of April, 1881, and from the first day of April, 1881, to the first day of April, 1884: *provided*, that not less than fitteen miles of said railroad extending from the city of Milwaukee westward, shall be constructed and in operation on or before April 1, 1881.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 92.

AN ACT relating to special terms of court in the third judicial circuit.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. At any special term of the circuit Business done court in the third judicial circuit of this state, any and at special terms all business may be done arising in any county of said circuit, which might be done at a general term, except the trial of issues of fact by a jury.

CHAPTER 93.

AN ACT to change the time of holding the annual meeting of the county board of St. Croix county, and to repeal chapter two hundred and thirty-eight of the general laws of Wisconsin for 1875.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The county board of supervisors of St. Meetings of Croix county shall meet annually, on the Tuesday next board. succeeding the second Monday in November in each year, at the county seat of said county, for the transaction of business as a board of supervisors. They may also hold special meetings when necessary, at such times and places as they may find convenient, and shall have power to adjourn from time to time, as they may deem it necessary.

Repealed.

SECTION 2. Chapter two hundred and thirty-eight of the general laws of the state of Wisconsin for 1875, entitled an act to change the time of holding the annual meeting of the county board of St. Croix county, and to amend section twenty-six (26), chapter thirteen (13), of the revised statutes, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 94.

AN ACT to amend section two thousand and one, chapter ninety-one, of the revised statutes of 1878, entitled of religious societies.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section two thousand and one, chapter ninety-one, of the revised statutes of 1878, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Section 2001. Every religious society organized or attempted to be organized under chapter forty-seven of the revised statutes of 1849, or chapter sixty-six of the revised statutes of 1858, by filing or having recorded a certificate of the election of trustees, designating the name of the church, with the clerk of the board of supervisors, clerk of the circuit court or register of deeds, and which since such filing or recording, has acted as a religious corporation in pursuance thereof, shall be deemed to have been and to be legally incorporated, and shall have all the powers and be subject to all the liabilities of religious corporations under the provisions of this chapter.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
