CHAPTER 97.

AN ACT for the relief of Sarah Jane Tarr, and to appropriate to her a sum therein named.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

There is hereby appropriated to Sarah Appropriation, Section 1. Jane Tarr, out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of one hundred and fifty-one dollars and nineteen cents, in full for compensation for costs and damages sustained by her owing to the failure of the title to the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter of section number twenty-one, in town fifteen, north of range number eight east, and which said land was patented to her by the said state of Wisconsin on the twenty-sixth day of August, in the year 1866, said patent numbered eight thousand three hundred and fifty-eight.

Section 2. The above amount, if allowed, shall be in full payment of all claims against the state for purchase money, or for damages sustained by reason of defective title to northwest quarter of southwest quarter of section twenty-one, town fifteen, north of range eight east.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

AN ACT to amend section four hundred and one, chapter twenty-six, revised statutes, entitled of normal schools and

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section four hundred and one, chapter Manner of autwenty-six, of the revised statutes, entitled of normal diting and paying accounts. schools and academies, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: All payments for the erection, repairs or enlargement of any normal school building, or for fixtures and furniture therefor, and all disbursements from the normal school fund income, including the
