## CHAPTER 122.

AN ACT to appropriate to the northern Wisconsin agricultural and mechanical association a sum of money therein named.

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of Appropriation, the general fund to the northern Wisconsin agricultural and mechanical association the sum of one thousand dollars.

## CHAPTER 123.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hunderd and forty-one of the laws of 1879, in relation to the distribution of the blue book.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter one hundred and Amended. forty-one of the laws of 1879, entitled an act to amend section one hundred and twenty-one of chapter two of the revised statutes of 1878, in relation to the distribution of blue books, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: the secretary of state shall cause to be printed four thousand and five hundred copies of such blue book annually, to be distributed as follows: Twenty-Distribution of five copies to each member of the senate and assembly, Blue Books. five copies each to the chief clerks and sergeants atarms of the two houses, one copy to each of the clerks and employes of the two houses, whose names appear in the blue book; fifty copies each to the governor, secretary of state and superintendent of public instruction; twenty-five copies each to the lieutenant governor, state treasurer and attorney general; two copies each to the rest of the state officers in the capitol, and one to each of their assistants; one copy each to the state agricultural society, the state horticultural society, the state board of charities and reform, and to the academy of arts and science; one copy to each regent of the state university and normal schools, one copy to each of the college, academy, free high school, normal school and free public libraries of the state, and to the state
