

common council of the said city shall meet some time during the month of March of each year, on or before the third Tuesday of the said month, and determine what compensation or salary shall be paid to each of the officers of the said city for the ensuing year, and such compensation or salary of the said officers after being so determined as aforesaid, shall not be increased or diminished during the term of office of said officers; and in case the said common council shall neglect or fail to meet, or neglect or fail to determine the compensation or salary to be paid to the said officers for the ensuing year, as hereinbefore provided, then the said officers and each of them shall receive the same compensation or salary as their immediate predecessors.

CHAPTER 125.

AN ACT relating to embezzlement, and to amend section four thousand six hundred and sixty-seven of the revised statutes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section four thousand six hundred and sixty-seven of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto the following: This section shall apply to every offense of embezzlement mentioned in section four thousand four hundred and eighteen of the revised statutes.

CHAPTER 126.

AN ACT to amend subdivision c, of section one thousand nine hundred and forty-six of chapter eighty-nine of the revised statutes of 1878, entitled of insurance corporations.

SECTION 1. Subdivision c, of section one thousand nine hundred and forty-six of chapter eighty-nine of the revised statutes of 1878, is hereby amended by striking out the words "to publish" after the word "state," in the second line of said section, and substituting the words, "or any agent thereof to permit or cause to be," so that said section when so amended
