CHAPTER 13.

AN ACT to authorize the levy of a special tax in the tenth ward of the city of Milwaukee.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Additional tax of two and onethe dollar of valuation authorized.

The common council of the city of Milwaukee is hereby authorized and empowered, at the time of levying other city taxes for the years 1880 and 1881, in addition to the amount now authorized to be raised by law for ward purposes in the tenth ward of said city in each of said years, to levy a tax of not exceeding two and one-half mills on the dollar upon all taxable property, real and personal, in said ward, for each of said years 1880 and 1881. Said tax shall be collected at the same time and in the same manner as other city taxes for said years are collected, and shall be used for ward purposes in said ward.

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in

force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 14.

AN ACT to authorize the levy of a special tax in the ninth ward of the city of Milwaukee.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Additional tax of three mills valuation authorized.

The common council of the city of on the dollar of Milwaukee is hereby authorized and empowered, at the time of levying other city taxes for the years 1880, 1881 and 1882, in addition to the amount now authorized to be raised by law for ward purposes in the ninth ward of said city, in each of said years, to levy a tax of not exceeding three mills on the dollar, upon all taxable property, real and personal, in said ward, for each of said years 1880, 1881 and 1882. Said tax shall be collected at the same time and in the same manner as other city taxes for said years are collected, and shall be used for ward purposes in said ward.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
