## CHAPTER 135.

AN ACT for the preservation of fish in Long lake, Round lake and Mud lake, situate in the counties of Fond du Lac and Sheboygan.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :*

Waters where-  
in fish may not  
be taken.

SECTION 1. No person or persons shall take, catch or kill, with any net, seine, wire basket, spear, grapple, trap, hook and line, or any device whatever, fish of any kind in either of the lakes known as Long lake, Round lake, and Mud lake, situate in the counties of Fond du Lac and Sheboygan, state of Wisconsin, or in any stream or waters connecting said lakes or either of them, or in any stream or waters emptying into said lakes or either of them, between the first day of March and the tenth day of May in any year. Any person violating the provisions of this section, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof, shall be punished by fine of not less than five dollars nor more than fifty, with costs of suit, or in lieu of such fine and costs, the court may, in its discretion, upon such conviction, imprison the party so convicted, in the county jail of the proper county, not exceeding thirty days.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 136.

AN ACT to authorize the commissioners of public lands to loan a portion of the trust funds of the state to the county of Brown.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. The commissioners of public lands are hereby authorized to loan a portion of the trust funds of this state, not exceeding fifty thousand dollars, to the county of Brown, in this state, and the county of Brown is hereby authorized to borrow a sum, not exceeding the amount above named, of said commissioners, for the purpose of redeeming certain railroad bonds that will become due during the year 1880, said county to issue to said commissioners certificates of the indebtedness so contracted.
