part of and shall hereafter consistute a part of the school district now belonging to the city of Jefferson, Jefferson county, Wisconsin, for school purposes only, and for such purpose shall be under the management of the board of education of the city of Jefferson, in said county.

Territory added to joint school district of Aztalan and Jeffercon.

Repealed.

SECTION 2. The south one-half of the southeast quarter of section number four, in said town and range, is hereby made a part of joint school district number four, of the towns of Aztalan and Jefferson, in said county.

SECTION 3. All acts or parts of acts heretofore passed inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This act shall be published in the Jefferson Banner, a newspaper published in the city of Jefferson, Jefferson county Wisconsin, and shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 198.

AN ACT relating to the killing of deer in Door county, and amendatory of section four, chapter forty, of the laws of 1879.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Amend said section four of chapter forty, as follows: Strike out all after the word "county," in the sixth line, and insert in lieu thereof the following: No person or persons shall be allowed to hunt, worry or kill any buck, doe or fawn after nightfall, by the aid of any police lantern, torch light, or any other artificial light.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
