CHAPTER 50.

AN ACT to amend chapter two hunderd and sixty of the laws of Wisconsin for 1877, entitled an act to revise, consolidate and amend the charter of the city of Stevens Point, approved May 17, 1858, and the several acts amendatory thereof.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section thirteen of chapter eleven of Section as amended. said chapter two hundred and sixty of the laws of Wisconsin for 1877, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Section 13. The common council of the city of Stevens Point shall annually, at the time of levying city taxes, levy a highway tax of not less than one or more than five mills on the dollar upon all of the taxable property of said city, as the same shall appear upon the corrected assessment rolls of said property, for the purpose of constructing and repairing streets, highways and bridges in said city, which tax so levied shall be collected or returned at the same time and manner as other city taxes are collected or returned by law.

SECTION 2. All acts and parts of acts conflicting Conflicting acts

with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 51.

AN ACT to legalize the acts of George R. Mahoney, Henry P. Fischer, and H. J. L. Meyer, deputy clerks of the city of Milwaukee.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The official acts of George R. Ma-Legalized. honey, Henry P. Fischer, and H. J. L. Meyer, in administering and certifying oaths, while acting as deputy city clerks of the city of Milwaukee, for the years 1878 and 1879, are hereby legalized and declared valid.

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force
