CHAPTER 72.

AN ACT to amend chapter three of chapter seventy-two of the private and local laws of 1858, entitled an act to incorporate the city of Ripon.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter three of chapter seventy-two Superintendent of the private and local laws of 1858, is hereby amended by adding to said chapter, sections ten and eleven, as follows, to-wit: Section 10. The common council of the city of Ripon shall have power, whenever a distinction shall exist in Fond du Lac county between county poor and town poor, to appoint a city superintendent of poor, who shall, under the direction of said common council, have charge of the poor of said city.

SECTION 2. Section 11. The city superintendent Term of office; bonds; compenof poor shall hold his office during the term of the sation. council that appoints him, unless it shall sooner remove him. He shall give bonds in such sum as the council may require, and shall receive such compensa-

tion as it shall determine.

SECTION 3. All acts or parts of acts conflicting herewith are hereby repealed.

This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
