half day, to each member of the commission, for the time actually and necessarily employed.

SECTION 8. This act shall not be construed as here. Not a corporation or attempting to create a corporation, or a corporate organization under the laws of Wisconsin.

SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 80.

AN ACT to appropriate to David Wetherby and William James a sum of money therein named.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

There is hereby appropriated to David Appropriation. SECTION 1. Wetherby and William James, out of any money in the general fund not otherwise appropriated, the sum of twenty-three hundred and fifty-three dollars, to assist in defraying the expenses of litigation, by which the title of the state of Wisconsin to the sixteenth sections of lands embraced in the Indian reservation in said state was established: provided, that no money shall become due or payable under the provisions of this act until the said David Wetherby and William James have filed with the secretary of state a receipt in full of all demands upon the state in consequence of said litigation, and an agreement that they do not make and will not make at any time hereafter any claim upon the state on account of the litigation which is set forth in this bill.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
