CHAPTER 17.

AN ACT relating to the practice under the civil jurisdiction of the county courts of Winnebago, Fond du Lac and Dodge counties.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The judges of the county courts of Winnebago, Fond du Lac and Dodge counties, shall not be required to call the calendar for trial in its order at any regular term thereof, sitting as courts of civil jurisdiction, but may in the discretion of any such judge set down the cases on such calendar for trial at times certain, upon the stipulation of the parties, or on the application of either party entitled to move the cause, upon notice of such intended application to the opposite party, and may by rules regulate and prescribe the practice in relation to setting down cases for trial, and striking juries, and issuing venirens in cases wherein juries are required. Said county court shall be deemed to be open for the transaction of business from the commencement of any regular term thereof until any such term is adjourned without day, or until the next regular term thereof, and no adjournment from day to day shall be necessary to the validity of any proceedings in said courts, but no per diem shall be allowed to any officer of said courts excepting for days on which said courts are actually in session, transacting business.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 18.

AN ACT to amend section two thousand four hundred and sixty-nine of the revised statutes, in relation to terms of county courts.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section two thousand four hundred and sixty-nine of the revised statutes, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Section 2469. The terms of the county courts in said counties for the transaction of civil business shall be held as follows: In the county of Brown, on the first Monday in February,
