Money derived to be paid into state treasury. SECTION 2. The superintendent shall pay over all moneys derived from the sale of such blue books to the state treasurer, to become a part of the general fund.

CHAPTER 259.

AN ACT to provide for the correction of errors in state assessments

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

How error of board shall be corrected. SECTION 1. In any case where the state board of assessment, through mistake or inadvertence, has heretofore assessed or shall hereafter assess to any county, a greater or less valuation, for any year, than should have been assessed to such county, said board shall, in the next succeeding state assessment, correct such error by adding to or subtracting from (as the case may be) the valuation of such county as determined by it, at such succeeding state assessment, the amount omitted from or added to the true valuation of such county in the former state assessment in consequence of such error, and the result shall be taken as the true valuation of such county for the latter year, and a final correction of such error.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
