## CHAPTER 76.

AN ACT to amend subdivision four of section three thousand three hundred and fifty-one of the revised statutes of 1878.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subdivision four of section three thousand three hundred and fifty-one of the revised statutes of 1878, is hereby amended by striking out the word "three," in the second line of said subdivision of said section, and inserting in lieu thereof the word "twelve," so that the subdivision of said section, when so amended, shall read as follows: Section 3351. division 4. That the action in which such attachment Amdavit for atis applied for, was commenced within twelve months tachment. after such debt, demand or claim accrued or became payable, and no other or further affidavit shall be required for the purpose and except as otherwise provided in this chapter, the proceedings upon such attachment, in an action in the circuit court, shall be the same as provided in chapter one hundred and twentyfour, but no attachment shall be issued out of the circuit court in any such action, unless the amount claimed in such affidavit shall exceed the sum of one hundred dollars.

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 77.

AN ACT to authorize John G. Nelson and William Long to erect, maintain and keep up a dam across Hay creek, Burnett county, Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. John G. Nelson and William Long, Location. their associates and assigns, are hereby authorized to erect, maintain and keep up a dam across Hay creek, on section twelve (12), in township forty (40) north, of range eleven (11) west, in Burnett county, Wisconsin: provided that such dam shall not raise the water to exceed twelve feet.

SECTION 2. The aforesaid persons, their associates Slides to be or assigns, shall build suitable slides in said dam for kept open.
