CHAPTER 87.

AN ACT relating to and amendatory of section ten of sub-chapter six of chapter sixteen of the private and local laws of the state of Wisconsin for the year 1872, entitled "an act to incorporate the city of Eau Claire."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section ten of sub-chapter six of chapter sixteen of the private and local laws of the state of Wisconsin for the year 1872, is hereby amended by adding at the end of said section ten the following: And provided further that whenever any one of the wards of said city shall through its representatives in the common council of said city, apply for permission and authority to construct a sewer wholly within the limits of said ward to be paid for by a special ward tax to be levied and assessed upon the taxable property real and personal in said ward, the said common council may thereupon by resolution or ordinance, grant permission and authority to said ward to construct such sewer wholly at the expense of said ward, and upon such further conditions as the said common council may prescribe. And if said common council shall so authorize the construction of any such sewer it shall and hereby is authorized and empowered to levy and collect by tax upon the taxable property, real and personal, in said ward, a sum sufficient to pay for such construction and all cost and expense incurred in relation to such sewer and the construction thereof; which tax shall be levied, assessed and collected as a special ward tax, at the same time and in the same manner as the taxes for general city purposes in said city of Eau Claire for the next ensuing year are now authorized by law to be levied, assessed and collected; and when collected the same shall be set apart and held in the treasury of said city as a special ward fund for the ward in which it may have been collected, and to be applied and paid out upon the order of the aldermen for such ward, for the purposes for which the same was so levied and assessed.

Construction of sewer wholly within ward.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.
