CHAPTER 170.

AN ACT vesting in assignees, in cases of voluntary assignments, the rights of creditors to avoid fraudulent conveyances, and amendatory of chapter 80 of the revised statutes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Rights and interests of creditors.

SECTION 1. In all cases of voluntary assignment for the benefit of creditors made under the provisions of chapter 80 of the revised statutes, the assignee or assignees shall be considered as representing the rights and interests of the creditors of the debtor or debtors making the assignment, as against all transfers and conveyances of property which would be held to be fraudulent or void as to creditors; and shall have all the rights which such creditors would have to bring and maintain an action to avoid such fraudulent conveyances and transfers.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force

from and after its passage and publication.
