

tween sections seventeen (17) and eighteen (18), township twenty-three (23) north, of range twenty-five (25) east.

Keep same in repair.

SECTION 2. It shall be the duty of said town board of supervisors, when said bridge is completed, to keep the same in good repair, and to keep at all seasons of navigation, sufficient manual force to open and close the same so as to admit the passage of vessels and other water crafts with the least possible delay.

Funds necessary.

SECTION 3. The funds necessary to build and maintain said bridge shall be raised by taxation upon all the taxable property in the said town of Kewaunee, to be levied and collected as other taxes in said town are levied and collected; provided, however, that the question of raising money to build such bridge be submitted to a vote of the qualified electors of said town at any annual town meeting as provided in subdivision 7 of section 776 of the revised statutes.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

### CHAPTER 233.

AN ACT to amend chapter 211 of the laws of 1881, entitled an act to encourage the manufacture of syrup and sugar, and for other purposes.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

Syrup and sugar.

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated for the professor of agriculture in charge of the experimental farm of the state university, out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of two thousand dollars, to be expended in the manner and for the purpose contemplated by chapter 211 of the laws of 1881 entitled "an act to encourage the manufacture of syrup and sugar, and for other purposes, and the disbursement of said money shall be subject to provisions of said chapter.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
