CHAPTER 294.

AN ACT to appropriate to the state agricultural society a sum of money therein named.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation. SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the state agricultural society the sum of two thousand dollars out of any money in the general fund not otherwise appropriated; provided, that their next annual exhibition shall not be held at the same time of the next annual exhibition of the northern agricultural and mechanical society.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 295.

AN ACT to lay out and establish a state road from the village of Medford, in the county of Taylor, to Cadott Falls, in the county of Chippewa.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

State road. SECTION 1. Thomas McDermot, Benjamin F. Milliard and Thomas McCort are hereby appointed commissioners with full power and authority to survey, lay out and establish a state road from the village of Medford, in the county of Taylor, to Cadott Falls, in the county of Chippewa, by way of the Miller dam and on the right bank or north side of the Yellow river, from said dam to Cadott Falls.

Map. SECTION 2. After said commissioners shall have laid out said road, or such portion as in their opinion the public good may require, but to extend into both of said counties in any event, they shall make out a correct map or plat of survey of the same and file it in the office of the county clerk in the different counties in which the same may be located.

Award damages. SECTION 3. Said commissioners shall have full power to award damages and settle with parties who may feel aggrieved or sustain damage by the laying out or establishing of said road. All claims for damage shall be made within one year from the time said commissioners shall have filed the plat or survey of the road in the offices of the county clerks, as required
