CHAPTER 60.

AN ACT to amend the act entitled an act to establish and maintain a public library in the city of Milwaukee, approved February 7, 1878.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 9 of the act entitled an act to Free library. establish and maintain a public library in the city of Milwaukee, approved February 7, 1878, is hereby amended so that the same shall hereafter read as follows, to wit: Section 9. The common council shall levy and collect annually, upon all the taxable property in said city, at the same time and in the same manner as other city taxes are levied and collected by law, a special tax of one-fourth of a mill upon each dollar of the assessed value of said taxable property, and the entire amount of said special tax shall be paid into, and held in the city treasury, as a separate and distinct fund, to be known as the "library fund," and the same shall not be used or appropriated, directly or indirectly, for any other purpose than for the maintenance and increase of the public library, the payment of the salaries of the librarian, assistants and other employes of the library, the purchase of books, furniture supplies and fuel, the expenses of rent and insurance, and the incidental expenses, including incidental repairs of the library rooms and furniture.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
