the appellant shall, at the time of perfecting such appeal, pay to the justice of the peace, the clerk's fees required to be paid by chapter 451, of the private and local laws of 1871. Such justice of the peace, shall, at the time of making a return to the appellate court of the testimony, proceedings and judgment, and filling the same therein, pay to said clerk, such clerk's fees in addition to the state tax.

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication. Approved March 21, 1883.

CHAPTER 109.

AN ACT to appropriate to the Wisconsin State Agricultural Society certain sums of money therein named.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Appropriation. Wisconsin State Agricultural Society, out of any money in the general fund not otherwise appropriated, the sum of two thousand dollars (\$2,000), for the year 1883, and the further sum of two thousand dollars (\$2,000) for the year 1884.

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after the passage and publication

thereof.

CHAPTER 110.

AN ACT to appropriate to the Northern Wisconsin Agricultural and Mechanical Association a sum of money therein

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of Appropriation. the general fund to the Northern Wisconsin Agricultural and Mechanical Association, the sum of two thousand dollars (\$2,000) for the year 1883 and the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for the year 1884.

This act shall take effect and be in SECTION 2. force from and after its passage and publication.
