

**Fees for same.** he, or they, shall have a right to lay and collect the sum of five (5) cents per thousand feet, board measure, for all logs so driven down over said improvement in said township twenty (20), range two (2) west.

**Liens.** SECTION 3. For all such tolls the said Hugh B. Mills, or assigns, shall have a lien on such logs, which may be enforced as mechanics' liens are enforced.

SECTION 4. This act shall not be construed to give said Mills any right or pretended right to make any of said improvements on any other than his own lands, or such lands as he has obtained the right to go on and make said improvement from the owners, but shall be subject to repeal, alteration or amendment at the discretion of the state legislature.

SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 318.

AN ACT to amend section 664 of chapter 36 of the revised statutes, entitled "of the county board."

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

**Relating to county board.**

SECTION 1. Section 664 of chapter 36 of the revised statutes, is hereby amended so as to make said section, when so amended, read as follows: Section 664. The county board shall meet annually on the first Tuesday after the second Monday in November, at the county seat, for the transaction of business as a board of supervisors. A special meeting shall be held only when requested by a majority of the members of said board, in writing, addressed and delivered to the county clerk, and specifying the time and place of such meeting, not less than one week therefrom; upon the reception of such request, the clerk shall immediately transmit a notice of such meeting to each of the members of said board.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
