CHAPTER 108.

AN ACT to alter territorial road between Racine and Waukesha.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. All the following described part of the territorial road from Racine, in Racine county, to Waukesha, in Waukesha county, lying in section fourteen, township number four, range number twenty-one east, is hereby vacated and discontinued, to wit: From the south line of said section, northerly forty-five rods, thence westerly and south-westerly to the west line of said section, ninety rods.

Relating to territorial road.

SECTION 2. A public highway is hereby laid upon the south line of said section, beginning at the south-west corner thereof, thence east one hundred rods, to the point where the east boundary of the road above vacated and discontinued, crosses said section line; and a public highway is likewise laid upon the west line of said section, from the south-west corner thereof, north ten rods, or to the point where the east boundary of the road above discontinued and vacated, crosses said west line of said section.

Road laid out—description of.

SECTION 3. Thomas Adland, of Raymond, William Neyde, of Raymond, and Byron Allen, of Raymond, are hereby appointed to consider and assess the damages, for the taking of the lands hereby taken for such highway, but from their award any land owner feeling himself aggrieved may appeal to the proper circuit court.

Damages to be assessed.

SECTION 4. The town board of the town of Raymond are hereby charged with the opening of

such highway; provided, that no part of the costs thereof, or of the damages for such lands taken shall ever be paid by the state of Wisconsin.

When act shall take effect.

SECTION 5. This act shall take effect upon its passage and publication, except that the road herein vacated shall not be discontinued, until the said town board shall formally open for travel the highway herein laid.

CHAPTER 109.

AN ACT relating to the termination and continuance of leases, and amendatory of section 2187, revised statutes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Relating to leases.

SECTION 1. Section 2187, of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding to said section the following words, to wit: "But such tenancy may be terminated at the end of any year after the expiration of said term, by either party to said lease, upon giving to the other party thereto, a notice in writing, not less than thirty days prior to the date of such expiration, that he elects to terminate such lease at the end of such year.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force after its passage and publication.
