CHAPTER 156.

AN ACT to appropriate to the Northern Wisconsin Agricultural and Mechanical Association a sum of money therein named.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation
for 1885 and 1886

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated, out of the general fund, to the Northern Wisconsin Agricultural and Mechanical Association, the sum of two thousand one hundred dollars for the year 1885, and the sum of two thousand one hundred dollars for the year 1886, provided, that no warrant shall be drawn by the secretary of state for the payment of the sum of money hereby appropriated, except upon the presentation of a sworn statement signed by the president and secretary of said Northern Wisconsin Agricultural and Mechanical Association, certifying that the sale of intoxicating liquors has been prohibited and prevented, upon the fair grounds of said society during the year for which the appropriation is made; neither has any gambling been permitted on the fair grounds during the same year.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
