

SECTION 5. No black bass shall be taken or killed in any manner in the waters herein described, between the first day of November and the succeeding first day of May in each year, under the same penalty as prescribed in this act for the violation of section 1.

No black bass fishing allowed except at certain seasons.

SECTION 6. Fish may be taken at any time and in any manner, in the waters of Dell Creek, below the lower dam.

Fish below the lower dam may be taken.

SECTION 7. The general laws of this state for the preservation of fish shall not apply to the waters herein described. All previous laws for the protection of fish in Dell Creek are hereby repealed.

Repealing clause.

SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication. Approved April 1, 1885.

## CHAPTER 214.

AN ACT to vacate a certain alley in the city of Milwaukee.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. The alley extending east and west between lots two, and three, in block sixty-six, in the fourth ward of the city of Milwaukee, in the state of Wisconsin, from the west line of said lots, east to Sixth street, also between lots one and four in the same block, commencing at the east line of lot one, and running thence west to the east line of Seventh street, in said city of Milwaukee, is hereby vacated; provided, that said alley shall be at all times accessible to the city of Milwaukee for the purpose of water distribution and sewerage.

Alley vacated.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication. Approved April 2, 1885.
