CHAPTER 218.

AN ACT to amend section 2313, chapter 105, revised statutes of 1878, entitled, "To fraudulent conveyances relating to personal property."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

To make chattel mortgage valid.

SECTION 1. Section 2313, of the revised statutes, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following: "Nor shall a chattel mortgage upon household furniture be valid unless the same be signed by the wife of the mortgagor, if he be a married man, and her signature witnessed by two witnesses."

CHAPTER 219.

AN ACT relating to the assessment and collection of taxes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

Assessment and collection of taxes.

SECTION 1. The provisions of section 1210b, of chapter 50, of the revised statutes, and of the several acts amendatory thereof, shall be construed, to extend to, include and be applicable to actions heard and determined upon default, as well as those tried upon issue joined.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
