CHAPTER 250.

AN ACT to discontinue a portion of a state road heretofore laid in Portage county, Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

State road discontinued.

SECTION 1. That so much of a state road heretofore laid in Portage county, Wisconsin, as is described as follows: Commencing at the junction of roads on the bank of the marsh, north of the north branch of ten mile creek, near the northwest corner of the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of section number thirteen, in township number twenty-one north, of range number eight east, in the town of Pine Grove, in the county of Portage, thence running in a northeasterly direction to the point where it intersects the east line of the said town of Pine Grove, is hereby discontinued.

SECTION 2. This act shall be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 251.

AN ACT relating to voluntary assignments, and amendatory of section 1697, of the revised statutes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Relating to voluntary assignment.

SECTION 1. Section 1697, of the revised statutes, is amended by striking out, in the seventh and eighth lines of said section, the following words: "And a failure to make and file such inventory and list shall render such assignment void," so that said section, when so amended, shall read as follows: Section 1697.
