## CHAPTER 30.

AN ACT to authorize the Chicago, Freeport and St. Paul Railroad Company, its successors and assigns, to build, construct and maintain bridges for railway purposes over, and across the Eau Galle river at any points in the counties of Pepin, Pierce and Dunn.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The Chicago, Freeport and St. Paul Railroad Company, its successors and assigns, is hereby authorized to build, construct and maintain bridges for railway purposes over and across the Eau Galle river at any point or points in the counties of Pepin, Pierce and Dunn, in the state of Wisconsin, and for such purposes may erect piers, drive piles and build embankments and approaches in said river, and on the banks thereof, necessary for the proper and convenient construction and maintenance of such bridges; provided, that such bridge or bridges shall be so constructed as not to interfere with the free navigation of said river with rafts, logs, timber or lumber.

Authorized to build bridges, across the Eau Galle river.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 31.

AN ACT to establish the salaries of corresponding secretary, and assistant librarian of the State Historical Society of Wisconsin.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The annual salary of the corresponding secretary of the State Historical Society of Wisconsin, is hereby fixed and established at the sum of two thousand dollars, and the salary

of the assistant librarian of said society is hereby fixed and established at the sum of twelve hundred dollars per annum. The above salaries to commence with the present year, and be paid as other salaries are paid. There is hereby appropriated annually out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, a sum of money sufficient to pay said salaries.

SECTION 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 33.

AN ACT to amend chapter 294, of the laws of 1883, entitled "An act to provide for the organization of trust companies."

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Chapter 294, of the laws of the year 1883, entitled "An act to provide for the organization of trust companies," is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Ten or more adult persons, residents of this state, may form a corporation in the manner provided by chapter 86, of the revised statutes, for the following purposes, to wit:

1. To act as the fiscal or transfer agent of any state, municipality or corporation, and in such capacity to receive and disburse money, and trans-
