CHAPTER 337.

AN ACT amendatory of section 3, of chapter 345, of the laws of 1883, entitled, "An act to license telephone companies."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 3, of chapter 345, of the laws of 1883, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Section 3. The annual license fee provided for in the preceding section, shall be one and one-half per centum of the gross receipts of the business within the state. License fee of telephone companies.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 338.

AN ACT to provide for the issuing of sheriffs' deeds in certain cases.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. In all cases where any sale has been or may hereafter be made by any sheriff under or in pursuance of any order, judgment or decree of any court, and such sheriff did not, or shall not, before the expiration of his term of office, execute a deed to carry such sale into effect, such deed may be executed by the successor of such sheriff in office at the time of the application for such deed, and any deed so executed by any successor of the sheriff, making such sale while in office, shall have the same force and effect as though the same had been executed by the sheriff making such sale. Regarding the issue of sheriffs' deeds in certain cases.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
