

Upon such certificates the accounts of the person named therein shall be audited and paid out of the state treasury. At the close of each session of the legislature, the secretary of state shall publish in the official state paper a full list of the accounts so audited.

SECTION 3. All acts and parts of acts ^{Repealing.} contravening the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after the first day of May, 1885.

CHAPTER 409.

AN ACT to legalize the election and the acts of the inspectors of said election, held in the village of South Chippewa.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The special village election held in ^{Legalized.} the village of South Chippewa, Chippewa county, on the second day of January, 1885, and the acts of the inspectors of such election are hereby in all respects legalized and declared valid and effectual for the purposes for which said election was held.
