## CHAPTER 72.

AN ACT to repeal chapter 430, of the private and local laws for the year 1868, entitled “An act to incorporate the Apple River Log Driving Company;” and chapter 206, of the laws of the year 1878, entitled “An act to amend and extend an act entitled ‘an act to incorporate the Apple River Log Driving Company,’ approved March 6th, 1868;” and chapter 134, of the laws of the year 1882, entitled “An act relating to and amendatory of sections 1 and 3, of chapter 206, of the general laws of Wisconsin for the year 1878, entitled ‘An act to amend and extend an act entitled an act to incorporate the Apple River Log Driving Company,’” approved March 6th, 1868.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Chapter 430, of the private and local laws for the year 1868, entitled “An act to incorporate the Apple River Log Driving Company,” and chapter 206, of the laws of the year 1878, entitled “An act to amend and extend an act entitled ‘an act to incorporate the Apple River Log Driving Company,’ approved March 6th, 1868;” and chapter 134, of the laws of the year 1882, entitled “An act relating to and amendatory of sections 1 and 3, of chapter 206, of the general laws of Wisconsin for the year 1878, entitled ‘An act to amend and extend an act entitled ‘an act to incorporate the Apple River Log Driving Company,’’ approved March 6th, 1868,” are hereby repealed. Repealed.

SECTION 2. Nothing herein contained shall be construed to affect the title to any property, real or personal, now owned by said Apple River Log Driving Company, or the right of said company to sell, transfer or dispose of the same. No titles to be affected.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
