The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The charter election of the city of Extending time La Crosse, appointed and required to be held on charter elec. the first Tuesday of April, 1887, is hereby $ex_{\text{La Crosse}}$, tended and postponed to the third Tuesday in April, 1887, and said charter election shall not be held prior to said third Tuesday of April, 1887. If such postponement will otherwise cause a vacancy in any office in said city, the term of such office shall be extended until such office is filled by appointment or election, or until the office is abolished.

CHAPTER 105.
