CHAPTER 190.

AN ACT to amend section 3723, of the revised statutes, relating to garnishments.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Amending sec.
3723, R. S.

SECTION 1. Section 3723, of the revised statutes, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following: And the garnishee, if he has property in his possession or under his control belonging to the defendant, may further answer that said property is exempt from execution, but said garnishee shall not be compelled to set up said exemption, and shall in no manner be held liable to said defendant or to any other person for failure to set up such exemption.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 191.

AN ACT to amend subdivision 2, of section 3702, of the revised statutes, entitled, "of actions by attachment and garnishment."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Amending sec.
3702 R. S.

SECTION 1. Subdivision 2, of section 3702, of the revised statutes, entitled, "of actions by attachment and of garnishment," is hereby amended so as to read as follows: 2. That the defendant is not a resident of this state.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
