## CHAPTER 259.

AN ACT to amend section 12, of chapter 359, of the private and local laws of 1871, entitled, "an act to incorporate the city of Manitowoc."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Assessment against lots for work on sewers.

SECTION 1. Section 12, of chapter 359, of the private and local laws of 1871, is hereby amended so that the same shall read as follows: Section 12. Sewers may be ordered by the board of aldermen and built at the expense of the lots or parcels of lots abutting upon the streets or alleys through which such sewers may be located; and the cost of such sewers shall be apportioned among such lots by the city clerk upon the last assessed valuation of said city, in the same manner as the cost of grading and improving streets; provided, however, that when such sewers are constructed through alleys, no lots or parcels of lots shall be assessed therefor except those situated in the block or blocks through which such sewers shall pass, and when sewers are constructed through streets, no lots or parts of lots shall be assessed therefor except those situated in blocks fronting on such streets. The mode of proceeding in ordering such work for the construction of sewers. the assessing and collecting taxes therefor, and the publishing of notices in regard thereto, shall be in all respects similar to that prescribed in this chapter for the grading and improving of streets, and all acts or parts of acts conflicting with this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
