## CHAPTER 262.

AN ACT to authorize Jacob Leinenkugel, his legal representatives and assigns, to construct, maintain and operate a dam across Duncan creek, in the city of Chippewa Falls, in Chippewa county.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

Authorizing Jacob Leinenkugel to maintain a dam across Duncan creek, (Chippewa Falls.

SECTION 1. Jacob Leinenkugel, his representatives and assigns, are hereby authorized and empowered to erect, construct, repair, maintain and operate a dam for manufacturing purposes across Duncan creek, on blocks fourteen and fifteen, Allen's addition to the city of Chippewa Falls, Wisconsin, situated on the northeast quarter of the northeast quarter of section six, township twenty-eight north, of range eight west, Chippewa county, Wisconsin; provided, said dam shall not exceed ten feet in height above low water mark, nor shall it be of such a height as to cause the flowage or back water therefrom to, in any manner, interfere with or impair the operation, use or enjoyment of the dam or water power now on said Duncan creek above the site of the dam mentioned in this act; provided, further, that said dam shall not be constructed, maintained or operated so as to interfere with the reconstruction, maintenance and operation for manufacturing pur-

poses, of the dam or dams heretofore maintained across said creek, below the point mentioned for the dam herein authorized; provided, further, said dam shall be so operated as not to materially or unnecessarily obstruct the natural flow of water in said Duncan creek; provided, that the legislature hereby reserves the right to alter, amend or repeal the franchises granted in this act whenever, in the judgment of the legislature, it is necessary or proper to do so.

Right to alter, amend or repeal, reserved.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 263.

AN ACT empowering the making and filing a list of jurors for St. Croix county for the year 1887.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The sheriff, county clerk and clerk of the circuit court for St. Croix county are hereby authorized and empowered to make and file a list of jurors for the year 1887, which said list when so made and filed with the clerk of the circuit court, shall for the year 1887 only, have the same force and effect as if made and filed under section 2527, of the revised statutes. Said officers shall conform as nearly as may be to the provisions of chapter 116, of the revised statutes in said selection of jurors.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
