

held as follows: In the county of Door, the first Tuesday in February and the Tuesday after the first Monday in September; in the county of Marinette, the first Monday of October, the second Monday of January and the first Monday of May; in the county of Oconto, the second Monday of April and the second Monday of November; in the county of Brown, the fourth Monday of November, the first Monday of March and the first Monday of June. Every term in the counties of Brown, Oconto and Marinette shall also be a special term for the whole judicial circuit.

SECTION 2. The jurors for each term of court shall be summoned to appear at or before the hour of nine o'clock A. M. on the second day of the term.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 1887.

CHAPTER 83.

AN ACT to appropriate the sums of money therein named to the charitable, reformatory and penal institutions of the state.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the general fund not otherwise appropriated, to the institutions below named, the following sums of money, for the purposes specified, to-wit: To the Wisconsin state hospital for the insane for current expenses, including painting and necessary repairs, to January 1, 1889, one hundred and fifteen thousand dollars. To the northern hospital for the insane for current expenses, including painting and necessary repairs, to January 1, 1889, one hundred and thirty-one thousand dollars. To the Wisconsin school

for the deaf for current expenses, including painting and necessary repairs to March 1, 1889, eighty thousand dollars. To the Wisconsin school for the blind for current expenses, including painting and necessary repairs to March 1, 1889, forty-five thousand dollars. To the Wisconsin industrial school for boys for current expenses, including painting and necessary repairs, to January 1, 1889, seventy-five thousand dollars. To the Wisconsin state prison for current expenses, including necessary repairs and painting, to March 1, 1889, thirty thousand dollars.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 84.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money therein named.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation
to W. C. Gilbert—\$90.50.

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to W. C. Gilbert, out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of ninety dollars and fifty cents in payment of the purchase price of state lands to which the state had no title, paid by said W. C. Gilbert.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
