## CHAPTER 124.

AN ACT to purchase ground for a permanent camp and rifle range for the Wisconsin National Guard.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

Authorizing purchase of grounds for camp, etc., for Wisconsin National Guard.

SECTION 1. The governor is hereby authorized to purchase for the state not to exceed six hundred acres of land, at or near Camp Douglas in Juneau county, as a permanent camp ground and rifle range for the Wisconsin National Guard, and to cause the same to be improved and fitted up in a convenient manner for those purposes; provided, that the sum to be paid for the land shall not exceed six hundred dollars, and that the total amount expended for all purposes shall not exceed five thousand dollars.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated out of the general fund a sum sufficient to accomplish the purposes aforesaid, the same to be expended under the direction and approval of the governor.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 125.

AN ACT to authorize the State Board of Supervision to purchase a tract of land adjoining the state hospital.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The State Board of Supervision is hereby authorized, at their discretion, to purchase,

for the state, a tract of land about one acre in extent, adjoining the grounds of the state hospital.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 127.

AN ACT authorizing the exclusion of certain persons from the trial of causes of a scandalous or obscene nature.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. That when, in any court, a cause of a scandalous or obscene nature is on trial, the presiding judge or justice may, in his discretion,
