## CHAPTER 269.

AN ACT to repeal chapter 213, of the laws of 1887, entitled, an act to amend sections 1886, 1887, 1888 and 1892, of the revised statutes of Wisconsin, entitled "of plank and turnpike corporations."

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

Repeal of chapter 213, laws 1887, and restoring sections 1886, 1887, 1888, 1892, R. S.

SECTION 1. Chapter 213, of the laws of 1887, entitled, an act to amend sections 1886, 1887 and 1888, of the revised statutes of Wisconsin, entitled "of plank and turnpike corporations," is hereby repealed, and said sections 1886, 1887, 1888 and 1892, as they appear in said revised statutes, are hereby restored and re-enacted.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 270.

AN ACT to amend an act, entitled, "An act to authorize Leander Choate, his associates, heirs and assigns, to build and maintain a dam across Eagle river, in Oneida county, Wisconsin," approved April 14, 1887.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

Amending chapter 512, laws 1877, authorizing Leander Choate et al., to build a dam across Eagle river, Oneida county.

SECTION 1. Section 1, of the act entitled, "An act to authorize Leander Choate, his associates, heirs and assigns, to build and maintain a dam across Eagle river, in Oneida county, Wisconsin, approved April 14, 1887," is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Section 1. Leander Choate,
