CHAPTER 6.

AN ACT to change the name of the Wisconsin female college of Fox Lake, in the county of Dodge.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The name of the Wisconsin female college, located at Fox Lake, in the county of Dodge, is hereby changed to Downer college, and the action of the board of trustees of said college at its annual meeting held in July, A.D. 1887, in the direction of such change, is hereby approved, ratified and confirmed.

Name of Wisconsin Female College, Fox Lake changed to Downer College.

SECTION 2. The said college shall hereafter bear the name of Downer college, and it shall be unlawful to change such name without legislative authority.

Name not to be changed without legislative authority.

SECTION 3. This act shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage and publication.
